In this situation, carefully use a screwdriver to punch a small hole in the centre of the bulge. This controlled release allows the water to drain into your buckets, preventing the entire heavy ceiling panel from collapsing into your living room. Once the immediate weather hazard has passed, you must document the damage completely before anyone begins the cleanup process. Grab your camera and take high-resolution photographs of the interior water damage, the ceiling stains, and any fallen debris in your garden. Step outside and photograph the roof from the ground, capturing images of missing shingles, exposed underlayment, or damaged flashing.
